SCEC has an important role to support our member groups and speak for the environment at every opportunity, and we hope you or someone you know can put their hand up to help out on our Management Committee. The Committee has great support from Leah Hays, our Coordinator, and Narelle McCarthy, Liaison and Advocacy, and I know you will find the experience very worthwhile.

This email is a call for nominations from member groups for individuals to come onto the Management Committee. **Nominations close at COB 15 June.** A nomination

form is attached and when completed can be scanned and emailed back to coordinator@scec.org.au.

Member Groups and members of the Management Committee can nominate a person for a position on the Management Committee. This person must be a member of SCEC or any of its Member Groups. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you would like members of the current Management Committee to nominate someone.

The nomination must be in writing; signed by the nominee and signed by no less than two Member Groups or members of the Management Committee or combination thereof; and given to the Secretary no less than 14 days before the Annual General Meeting at which the election is to be held. If insufficient nominations are received, nominations are able to be called from the floor at the AGM.

The Secretary shall be responsible for providing all members with a list of the candidate's names in alphabetical order, with the proposers and seconders names, and shall post a copy of the list in a conspicuous place in the SCEC office for at least seven days preceding the Annual General Meeting.
