

WEEKLY UPDATE FOR ALL RE CCG's....

Vic's news...

Spoke to Kylie at council asking about public liability should 'anyone' wander into the gardens and hurt themselves at any time.

She was going to consult the council legal advisor and get back to me. Hasn't done so yet. (Just txt'd her this morning again)

Also asked her about the possibility of putting a 1000L gravity water tank on top of the container, anchored securely. She saw no problems with it, but would still consult and get back to me. I've spoken to Noosa Building certifiers and Council Plumbing dept re the issue of a tank stand. Comes down to height. I have asked but I have yet to be told where the exact specifications are in the Building Regs. So a gravity tank (running off a solar powered 12v pump) seems possible if we follow the building code. But tank stands are definitely NOT illegal. Just need to be safe and comply.

Have called in twice to badminton courts but yet to meet anyone to discuss temporary use of their water supply or use of a power point.

One could be easily fitted in the electric meter box beside badminton entrance.

Re temporary water solution, I had a good look at the pipework coming out of the tanks.... A very easy initial solution would be to get a roll of 25mm pipe that could easily be connected to the existing connectors and this would take water flow to whichever garden bed we needed. Then connect to a hose/sprinkler as needed. 25mm pipe rolled up and put in container at end of the day.

One advert for expressions of interest is up at the Post Office noticeboard.

I have left one with the IGA managers but they are yet to approve/put it up.
