

<p>APRIL 2021 12th-19th</p>	<p><u>New Moon 1st Quarter</u> Plant annual above ground leafy plants with seed outside the fruit</p>	<p>Annual lupins, globe artichoke, Asian greens, cabbage, calendula, cauliflower, celery, chamomile daisy, chives coriander, cornflower, celery, Chinese cabbage, daikon radish, dill, endive, fennel (Florence), grain crops, kale, kohlrabi, leek, lettuce, mizuna, nigella, pansy, parsley, radicchio, rocket, silver beet, spinach (English), snow peas, spring onions, sweet pea, Tatsoi, coriander, nasturtium, viola, verbena</p>	<p><u>No planting 12 hours either side of New moon</u> In this quarter gravity pulls water up causing seeds to swell and burst. This with increasing light creates balanced leaf and root growth</p>
<p>2021 20th-26th</p>	<p><u>New Moon 2nd quarter</u> Annuals with above ground yield which are vines and produce seeds inside the fruit</p>	<p>Beans (broad, French & climbing), broccoli, chamomile daisy, calendula, cornflower, grain crops, kale, kohlrabi, leek, lettuce, pansy, parsley, peas, nasturtium, snow peas, sweet peas, spring onions, tomato, viola, verbena</p>	<p>Moonlight increasing creating strong leaf growth so is generally good for above ground leafy plant</p>
<p>2021 1st-3rd 27th-30th</p>	<p><u>Full Moon 3rd Quarter</u> Biennials, perennials, bulb and root crops Planted in one season to winter over and produce the following year. E.g. trees & shrubs</p>	<p>Asparagus crowns, beetroot, carrot, early season onion, garlic, globe artichoke, lavender, lemon balm, Jerusalem artichoke, Mediterranean herbs, mint, olive, parsnip, pineapple, potato, radish, strawberries, swede, turnip, watercress, yarrow</p>	<p><u>No planting 12 hours either side of the Full moon</u> Energy is drawing down creating more moisture in the soil and the moonlight is decreasing allowing for more energy to concentrate in the roots especially the 2 days after the full moon.</p>
